FairTSA Certificates

Dates

The FairTSA certificate needs to show the following dates:

- 1. Date of first FairTSA certification
- 2. Inspection Date
- 3. Expiration Date
- 4. Date of Issuance

Validity of Certificate is 18 months.

<u>Date of Issuance</u> should not be later than 90 days from the Inspection Date. <u>If</u> the Date of Issuance exceeds 90 days from Inspection Date, this time must be deducted from the 18 months validity. Examples:

- 1. Inspection date is June 15, 2020, date of issuance is September 1, 2020. In that case the certificate is valid through February 28, 2022.
- 2. Inspection date is June 15, 2020, date of issuance is November 15, 2020. Since the date of issuance is 150 days after the inspection, 60 days must be subtracted from the 18 months of validity. In this case, the certificate is valid until March 15, 2022.

Extension Letter

If a certificate has expired, a CCA or FairTSA may issue a letter extending the validity of the certificate for up to 60 days. After that period, the operation is automatically suspended.

An operation must comply with all requirements by the CCA and FairTSA before it can be reinstated.

Other Information

In addition to the requirements above, certificates must contain the following information and symbols:

- 1. Logos of the CCA and FairTSA in similar size
- 2. Full address of the CCA
- 3. Name and position of the signer
- 4. Certificate # (issued by the Certifier)
- 5. FairTSA producer ID#

- 6. The FairTSA's Certifier ID
- 7. The Scope of the certificate: Agricultural Production, Processing, or Trade
- 8. The following wording: <u>Only in combination with a FairTSA Licensing Agreement may a</u> buyer use the Fair Trade claim and the FairTSA logo.

Appendix

The following scope-related information needs to be contained:

Agricultural production

- 1. Certified products
- 2. Expected annual yield per certified product
- 3. Total size of operation in hectares or acres

Processing

- 1. Certified Products
- 2. Brand names, if any
- 3. Expected quantity of each processed product

Trading

- 1. Certified Products traded
- 2. Expected quantity of certified products to be traded
